

# Assessment

## Formative Assessment

1. Students are being assessed regularly by different means such as classwork, homework, quiz, test, project, ... etc. Students' learning progress is then reflected from their performance. Teachers would then adjust their teaching progress and strategies.
2. The performance of students' work contributes to their term mark.
3. In order to develop a regular revision habit in lower forms, regular quizzes will be arranged. There are about 2-3 quizzes per term for each subject.
