 I've always had a hankering to be a doctor.

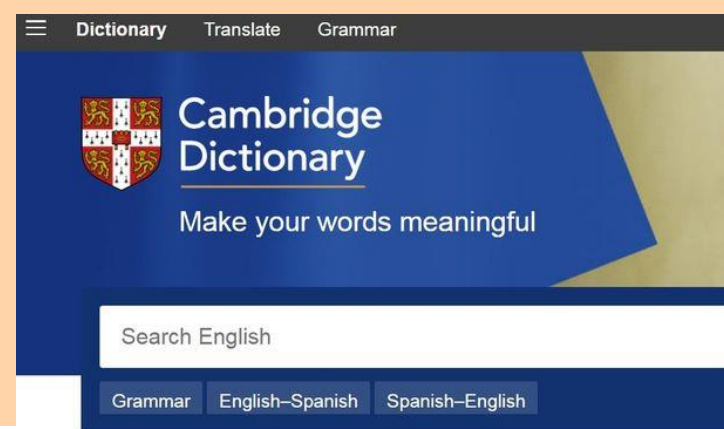
Examples from the Corpus
